

Justice and Judgment

- 1) *Ge 18:19 For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him. * H6666, 4941
- 2) Joh 5:30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. G1342, G2920
- 3) *Isa 9:7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.
- 4) *Isa 59:9 Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness.
*Isa 59:14 And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.
- 5) *Pr 21:3 To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 6) Pr 21:15 It is joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. H6662, 4941
- 7) **Ps 89:14 Justice and judgment are the habitation of thy throne: mercy and truth shall go before thy face. **H6664, 4941
- 8) **Pr 1:3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;
- 9) *1Ki 10:9 Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee, to set thee on the throne of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore made he thee king, to do judgment and justice.
*2Ch 9:8 Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee to set thee on his throne, to be king for the LORD thy God: because thy God loved Israel, to establish them for ever, therefore made he thee king over them, to do judgment and justice.
- 10) *2Sa 8:15 And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.
*1Ch 18:14 So David reigned over all Israel, and executed judgment and justice among all his people.

Job 36:17 But thou hast fulfilled the judgment of the wicked: judgment and justice take hold on thee. H4941, 1779

*Job 37:23 Touching the Almighty, we cannot find him out: he is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

**Ps 119:121 AIN. I have done judgment and justice: leave me not to mine oppressors.

*Isa 56:1 Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

Jer 22:15 Shalt thou reign, because thou closest thyself in cedar? did not thy father eat and drink, and do judgment and justice, and then it was well with him? H4941

*Jer 23:5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

Eze 45:9 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence and spoil, and execute judgment and justice, take away your exactions from my people, saith the Lord GOD.
